APIE Overview



This is a unique and innovative **2-day** masterclass and hands-on workshop on Advanced Procedures in Interventional Endoscopy. Interventional Endoscopy has traditionally included ERCP and EUS. However, the field has now expanded to more than just ERCP and diagnostic EUS with the development of new advanced endoscopic techniques. This has resulted in a new domain, often called “Flexible Endoscopic Surgery” or “Endoluminal Surgery”. These procedures are not readily available in many institutions. We therefore designed and started a unique course for hands-on learning and education in these advanced procedures. Our course has been sold out since 2017 and we are proud to host the 5th annual APIE course this year in person after a virtual offering last year.

This course will offer **small-group learning experiences for attendees, providing didactic lectures and ample hands-on time for advanced endoscopic techniques beyond ERCP and diagnostic EUS**. A specific focus of this program will be the next generation of endoscopic technology and devices, as well as cutting-edge techniques used by experts in the fields. There will be extensive discussion of endoscopic techniques, devices, and instruments through lectures, videos, and hands-on stations.



Target Audience

This workshop is designed for practicing gastroenterologists, interventional endoscopists and surgeons throughout the world as well as advanced endoscopy trainees interested in learning newer advanced endoscopic procedures. We will be restricting the total number of attendees to allow adequate hands-on time for attendees to learn and practice these newer endoscopic procedures.

Learning Objectives

At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

- 1) Analyze indications, contra-indications and techniques to optimize success in performing newer interventional endoscopic procedures such as POEM, ESD, Endoscopic Anti-reflux Therapies, Endoscopic suturing, EndoHepatology, and Interventional EUS.
 - 2) Implement best endoscopic treatment strategies for achalasia, gastroparesis, GERD, obesity, and early gastrointestinal neoplasia.
 - 3) Identify techniques and treatment strategies for obesity with intragastric balloons, endoscopic sleeve gastropasty and endoscopic Transoral Outlet Reduction.
 - 4) Compare endoscopic therapies in appropriate patients as alternatives to more invasive surgical options.
 - 5) Understand and minimize adverse events related to advanced procedures in interventional endoscopy.
